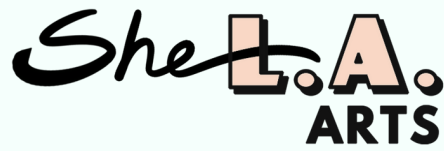

WELCOME!

We're thrilled to have you join us at the Zephyr Theater for SheLA's Summer Theater Festival! This guide has helpful information about what your experience will be like in the theater.

OUTSIDE OF THE THEATRE



The Zephyr Theatre can be found at 7456 Melrose Ave, Los Angeles, CA 90046.

The pink arrow above points to the entrance of the theater.

There is all-day parking on Waring, east of Sierra Bonita, except for street cleaning times.

There is metered parking on Melrose and 2-hour parking in the nearby neighborhood on Vista and Gardener south of Melrose Ave.

There are some parking structures or public valet parking within a block of the theatre.



ENTERING THE THEATRE

The entrance to the theatre is outside under the arrow-shaped billboards. Here you will enter through the metal gate into the box office area.



THE LOBBY



When you go past the entrance, you will go into the lobby area. Before the theater space opens, you will pick up your tickets at will call and wait for the performance. You will walk to the end of the purple mural to your left to reach the Will Call table.

WILL CALL



At the end of the purple mural is Will Call. There is a sign that says "Will Call" with a table in front of it. This is where you will check in for the performance and pick up your tickets.



CONCESSIONS

Directly across from the Will Call table is the concessions stand. Here you can buy snacks or drinks before the performances and during intermissions.



BATHROOMS



To get to the bathrooms, you go to the end of the lobby hallway. You will walk all the way to the theatre's entrance. You will take a right, where the blue arrow is pointing.

BATHROOMS



When you turn right, you will see a small hallway with two bathroom entrances. The restrooms are accessible for all genders. The blue arrows point the entrances for both bathrooms.

BATHROOMS



The bathrooms at the Zephyr Theatre are not wheelchair accessible. For a wheelchair accessible bathroom, we have permission to use Melrose Umbrella Co's bathroom directly across the street. The building says "TaCO" on the front of it.

There are two different entrances to the restaurant, and depending on the time of day, one may be closed. The blue arrows point to the two entrances. (It looks like two different restaurants, but they're actually the same place!)

ENTERING THE THEATER



Once the show is ready for audience members (which will be about 15 minutes before the performance time), you can walk to the end of the lobby hallway and enter through the dark blue doors. The blue arrow points directly to the entrance.

ENTERING THE THEATER

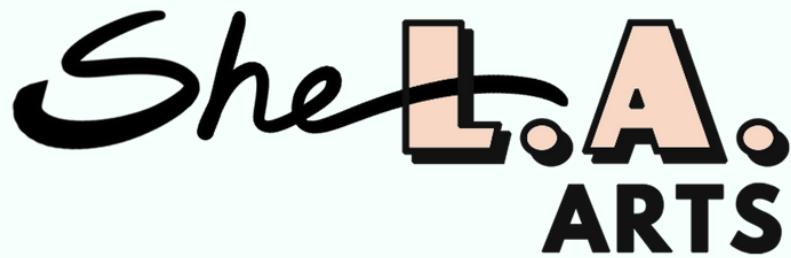


When you are in the theatre, you will see red seats on three sides of the space with the stage in the middle. There will be set pieces in the space when you enter, so be cautious when taking your seat, as to not bump into anything. An usher will be at the entrance to greet you if you have any questions or need assistance.

EXITING THE THEATER

Once the show is done, you will exit the front door of the theatre and will be able to leave through the lobby.
